Speed Limit on Triple R Ranch property is 10 mph Please be kind to our roads and buildings and drive the speed limit.

USE CODES:

- Guests agree to respect Triple R Ranch beliefs as set forth in the Statement of Faith. We are a Christian establishment and ask that you refrain from dishonorable language and conduct.
- The sponsor must be in control of retreat activities with chaperones as needed for proper supervision.
- Fires are restricted to designated areas. Guests should only use wood provided and under no circumstances is anyone to cut down trees or shrubs.
- Unless prearranged, quiet hours begin at 11:00PM.
- Ball playing and "rough housing" are not allowed in the buildings. Guests are responsible for any damages done to facilities.
- Any signs must be hung with Painters tape. Painters tape is available in the office at \$2.50 per roll.
- Smoking is limited to graveled areas and never allowed in buildings or wooded areas.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed.
- These areas are off limits without ranch supervision: the kitchen at Longhorn Lodge, the Barn, any corrals, fenced pastures, maintenance areas, box cars, the pool (except as contracted), private residences, family cemetery, and ropes courses.

Things you need:

- Pillow, twin-size bedding, or sleeping bag.
- Toiletries, towels, etc.
- Clothes appropriate for weather and activities you've scheduled.
- Closed-toe shoes are recommended for most of Triple R activities.
- Bug spray and sunscreen are useful during warmer months.
- One-piece bathing suit when using pool (or t-shirt to wear over ladies' two-piece suit)

Food Service:

Meal times for weekend groups are as follows:

Friday Night Supper only: 6:30pm

Breakfast: 8:15amLunch: 12:15pmSupper: 5:30pm

- When you enter Longhorn Lodge, you will have assigned tables for your group. Please take a seat and a Triple R Ranch Staff person will give instructions for the meal, pray, and then call you up by table to get your food.
- To keep our prices as low as we can, there are no seconds on food. At breakfast, we offer a cereal selection, and at lunch and dinner, we offer a salad bar in addition to the hot meal.

Things of Interest

• <u>Enjoy hiking on our trails.</u> The dirt road that goes behind the Ponderosa and by the Archery & Riflery Range is about a mile long. This is a well defined path and easy to follow. There are other well defined paths that loop off of this main trail if you want a longer walk. Some are better than others. If you are unsure, please stop by the office and ask for more information.

If you're walking a trail and see horses with riders, please step to the side and stand still. Allow horses and riders to see you. Horses always have the right-of-way so please allow them to pass and follow any instructions the Wranglers give you. If you come to a gate that is closed or a rope across the trail, this might mean they are getting ready to "run" the horses to pasture. Please do not enter any field or path that has been closed off.

- <u>Critter Corral</u> is our small farm animal area. You'll find miniature horses, sheep and goats. (Sheep and goats are usually allowed to roam freely. If they become a nuisance, please let us know.) Please do not feed horses by hand. They learn quickly to expect treats and therefore begin to bite. If you would like to give them grass, please place it in their feed tubs
- Our Camp Store ("Trading Post") has drinks, snacks and souvenirs. If your group would like to have it open, please stop by the office and let us know.
- The Game Room is attached to the Camp Store and is always open for your enjoyment (the "Trading Post").
- <u>The Basketball Court</u> is open if not reserved by a group. If you want to use this area at night, we will be happy to show you where the lights are located. Please turn lights off when you leave the area.
- <u>Israeli Dodgeball</u> (or Gaga Ball) and <u>Nine-Square</u> are also available if not reserved by a group. Balls are located at the Basketball Court; please return them when you are finished. Israeli Dodgeball pit is located by the Pond, and Nine-Square is located by the Sports Pavilion.
