This Will Change The Way You See

The 10 Commandments

Exodus 20

“I will *take you* as my own people, and I will be your God.”

(Genesis 6:7)

“take you” = *laqah* = reference to _____

“You came near and stood [beneath] the mountain while it blazed with fire to the very heavens...The Lord spoke to you out of the fire...He declared to you his covenant, the Ten Commandments.” (Deuteronomy 4:11-13)

In Jewish weddings, there is always a _____. This is a covering or canopy under which the couple stands during the wedding ceremony.

“Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow. Have them wash their clothes and be ready by the third day, because on that day the Lord will come down on Mt Sinai.” (Exodus 19:10-11)

At Jewish weddings, a woman is required to enter the _____ before the ceremony so that she might purify herself.

“Come up to me on the mountain. Stay there, and I will give you the tablets of stone on which I have inscribed the instructions and commands so you can teach the people.” (Exodus 24:12)

Before a Jewish wedding, vows are signed and written in a contract called a _____. A copy is given to both parties, just as two copies (tablets) were produced when God wrote the Ten Commandments.

Read through the 10 Commandments, viewing them through the lens of a marriage contract, and note how this changes the way you understand each of these commands and what they say about our relationship with the Lord.
